These specialized surgeons focus on patients with conditions affecting arteries, veins, and lymphatic systems, excluding those involving the heart and inner brain circulations. They perform open surgeries, endovascular catheter procedures, and non-invasive vascular assessments and interpretations.

Often they address issues including stroke prevention through the management of arterial blockages in the neck and upper chest, re-establishing blood flow to the upper and lower limbs suffering from inadequate circulation, handling aneurysms found in the abdomen and elsewhere, treating vascular injuries, and addressing varicose veins. Their treatments also comprise angioplasty—which involves placing stents in arterial blockages—and less invasive endovascular techniques for repairing abdominal aneurysms, alongside medical management of vascular disorders.
