

Continuing Education Activity Type & Fees

McLaren Health Care (MHC), Department of Interprofessional Continuing Education (IPCE) has successfully fulfilled accreditation requirements set forth by the American Osteopathic Association (AOA) to provide AOA Category 1-A credit and Joint Accreditation to provide *AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)™*. In support of improving patient care, McLaren Health Care is jointly accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education (ACCME), the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE), and the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC), to provide continuing education for the healthcare team. In addition, MHC can provide CE credit through the American Psychological Association (APA), Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB), Approved Continuing Education (ACE) program, and Commission on Dietetic Registration (CDR) under Joint Accreditation.

Services Offered:

- Direct Providership Activities that are planned and implemented by Mclaren Health Care Interprofessional Continuing Education Department.
- Co-Providership Activities in which MHC IPCE cooperates with one or more other
 accredited organizations to plan and execute an event. In this case, both organizations will
 need to be listed on any documents and marketing materials. However, one of the accredited
 providers must take responsibility for the activity in terms of accreditation requirements
 and reporting to the appropriate agencies.
- Joint Providership Activities that are jointly provided by MHC IPCE and a non-accredited organization.

CE Accreditation Fees:

Half Day (Less than 4 Hours): \$500*
One Day Live activities: \$750*
2 Day Live activities: \$1,250*
Each additional day over 2 days: \$2,000*
Enduring Materials: \$2,000*

Regularly Scheduled Series (RSS): \$1,500* per year (RSS) - Physician <u>and</u> Nursing

i.e. Grand Rounds, Tumor Boards, etc.

Accreditation

\$1,250 per year (RSS) - Single Profession Accreditation

This includes credit for two professions. An additional \$250 per profession if more than two is desired (Physicians, Nurses, Pharmacists and Techs, Dietitians, Psychologists, or Social

Workers)

Registration: \$25 minimum not to exceed \$50

(Discretion of the IPCE department and planning Committee)

Exhibitor or Sponsor: \$250 minimum not to exceed \$1000

(Discretion of the IPCE department and planning Committee)

Series-Type activities: For the purposes of this fee schedule, a series is the same activity held multiple times (and possibly locations) within one calendar year.
