REDUCING DISPARITIES IN CARE

In recent years, the overall health within the United States has improved. However, racial and ethnic minorities continue to experience lower quality of care. These patients are less likely to seek routine medical care and face high rates of morbidity and mortalities than non-minorities.

As a primary care provider, you play an important role in providing equitable care to your patients. McLaren Health Plan (MHP) wants to assist you with these efforts. It's important to understand the diversity of your patients and their needs. MHP's goal is to not have any disparities between any given race or ethnicity.

IDEAS FOR IMPROVEMENT:

- Provide easy-to-understand materials in a variety of languages to fit the demands of your patients
- Use interpreter services when needed with a patient with limited English proficiency
- Ask your patients to repeat the information you provided to ensure they understand
- Include your patients in decision making processes when appropriate
- Assist patients with filling out applications, forms, etc. when they are unable to
- Use your monthly HEDIS[®] report which includes your disparity rates by race and ethnicity for each applicable HEDIS measure
