

IMPORTANT CHANGES beginning January 1, 2019 for all McLaren Health Advantage Members!

At McLaren Health Advantage (MHA) our goal is to offer a high-quality provider network that includes McLaren's fully integrated health care network accompanied by other select In-Network providers to maintain access to affordable care for all employees. MHA would like to take this opportunity to inform you of some network changes beginning January 1, 2019. These changes impact the provider network and Pharmacy Benefit Manager. Below is a description of the changes.

Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM)

MHA is pleased to announce a new PBM for 2019. Effective January 1, 2019, MHA is transitioning to MedImpact. You will receive a new ID card that will have updated pharmacy information on it. You must present this new card to the pharmacy beginning January 1, 2019. Additional information along with your new ID card will be mailed to your home in December.

Provider Network
